Help plan the annual Children's BH Summit and the annual Parent Weekend Training. Meets 2nd Tues 6-8pm

Identify barriers and gaps in cross-system communication and services. Work to create plans and find strategic partners to collaborate with WSCC to educate families on the benefits of having one treatment plan across all systems they are involved with. Meets 4th Tuesdays of each month 10am-12Noon
